



Notification of The Electronic Transactions Development Agency
Subject: The intention of not accepting gifts and all kinds of rewards
for performing duties (No Gift Policy)
Fiscal Year 2024

According to the Cabinet resolution dated December 8, 2020 approved the national reform plan in the areas of prevention and suppression of corruption and misconduct (revised edition) which emphasizes the implementation of activities that will bring significant changes to the population (Big Rock) in Reform Activity 4. It focuses on developing the Thai bureaucracy to be transparent and without undue benefit. Goal 1, Section 1.1, states that all government agencies should declare themselves as units where every state official refuse gifts and rewards of any kind while performing their duties (No Gift Policy). The policy is required to be announced every fiscal year to promote awareness among government officials, discouraging the acceptance of any form of gifts and rewards while performing their duties.

The fiscal year 2024 has begun. Therefore, the Electronic Transactions Development Agency, as a government agency that emphasizes on integrity, transparency, and accountability in accordance with the Good Governance, hereby declares intention that the Electronic Transactions Development Agency, management, employees, and representatives of the Agency refuse to accept gifts and rewards of any kind while performing their duties (No Gift Policy) before, during, and after performing their duties to prevent any action that may cause unfair performance and a selective decision or conflict of interest including corruption and misconduct in their responsibilities.
